<p><b>Hip-Hop</b> Catch on to the latest dance craze! Learn the basic techniques of dance and how to move to the beat! This is a performance-based class, which helps students to gain confidence and self-esteem. Dance routines are taught which help students to develop sequential memory. Rock out to songs from Selena Gomez, Katy Perry, Carly Rae Jepsen, Black Eyed Peas, One Direction, classics from the past and all of your favorite radio tunes! A performance in funky costumes will be given on the last day of class to show off your new moves! <b>All grades/3:30-4:30</b> <b>August 22<sup>nd</sup>-October 3<sup>rd</sup></b></p> <p><b>TechKidz: Minecraft!</b> Come join us to learn about and play the most popular computer game on the planet! Learn Minecraft building techniques, details of command blocks, and how to change the look of the game. Kids learn strategy, team building, and cooperation skills while playing Minecraft in a fun, safe, and supervised environment! <b>2:45-3:45/K-1st</b> <b>3:45-4:45/2nd-5th grades</b> <b>August 22<sup>nd</sup>-October 3<sup>rd</sup></b></p>	<p><b>Mixed Media Art</b> Creative students who think outside the box will work with our artist to create clay sculptures and figurines, rock paintings, found art assemblages, painting on wood, 3-D collages mediums in pop art. Also, we will have folk art and surrealism such as Andy Warhol, Salvatore Dai &amp; Roy Lichtenstein. <b>All grades/3:30-4:30</b> <b>August 23<sup>rd</sup>-October 4<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>Tang Soo Go</b> Is an all-inclusive non-contact work-out. We incorporate all the traditional martial arts moves and exercises into a fun filled age appropriate class without the use of any contact. Our students gain confidence while improving stamina, coordination, flexibility and strength. <b>2:30-3:30/K &amp; beginners</b> <b>3:30-4:30-/1st-5th (advance)</b> <b>August 23<sup>rd</sup>-October 4<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>Don't Bug Me!</b> Butterflies, Beetles and Bugs, oh my! There are over one million different kinds of insects and almost as many fun facts. Students learn to recognize insect friends and enemies, and follow their life cycles from egg to adult. Among other fascinating facts, students learn which of the following is actually an insect - spiders, scorpions, crickets, or crabs. And compare their own athletic abilities to those of fleas! These young scientists also got a chance to make models of insects (creating legs and antennae for each model) and to draw vividly colored butterflies <b>All Grades/3:30-4:30</b> <b>August 24<sup>th</sup>-October 5<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>Creative Movement</b> In this class we will be having fun creating scenarios of animals walking through space and we will develop movement using circle dancing with props such as; parachutes, scarves other items. In this unique course, kids will enter the fascinating world of engineering while designing their own exciting rides using cutting-edge technology. Building machinery from scratch will introduce students to the fundamentals of robotics. As kids use infra-red remote controls, transmission gears and other electronic tools, they will develop thinking strategies, motor skills and dedication. Join us in an amusing and engaging journey into the exciting world of amusement park design! <b>2:45-3:45/K-1st</b> <b>3:45-4:45/2nd-5th grades</b> <b>August 25<sup>th</sup>- October 6<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>STORY WRITING</b> Unlock the creative freedom of telling your own stories by writing character driven stories in an artful way through the writing of the short story. A storyteller can use the skill to write comics, books, artwork &amp; screenplays. Everything is and can be a story. A tale is a magical piece of poetic enlightenment. Join us as we individually write weekly short stories &amp; share together on improving each other's work. You will grow your own veggies and herbs to plant at school and home.
